1. Welcome – meeting called to order by Alison.

3. Principal’s report – Andrea Greenhalgh

- **Went to camp today** – Div 1 & 2 at Sunshine Coast.
- Hard to believe that this time last year I was introduced for the first time.
- All of the mounted projectors for teachers who wanted mounted projectors are installed.
Four laser-type projectors. Unfortunately, the previous less expensive type are no longer available.
- Sports Day on June 20th (thanks to PAC for the popsicles- to be handed out at 2:15 at the school) The location is to be decided.
City of Vancouver has contacted us to see if we would like to be one of the next schools to take part in the Active Travel Programme, as we have the most successful Walking School Bus programme. They will present at one of the first PAC meetings in the fall to see if the community is on board. The programme is all about making access safer such as putting in crosswalks and roundabouts. Many schools like Shaughnessy have been part of this.
- Ultimate will finish up with Ms. Sara next week with a full-day jamboree at Prince of Wales High School.
- Wish List for Next Year (report attached – appendix 3)—Teachers and staff have compiled a wish list, which is ready for the Budget. The wish list totals \$5750. The teachers would like the Field trip budget of \$15 per student to continue.

- We could have some staffing changes and will announce them, once finalized, in a newsletter.
- **A huge thank you to all of our PAC executives and all the parents who took on huge jobs this year. Cavell is a wonderful school with an incredible community, and a lot of this has to do with the time and energy that our parents spend helping our kids.**

6. Douglas Park Community Centre report – Stratos Charalambides / Rosie Laforges

Alison read out Rosie Laforges report - Licensed Childcare Updates:

We are working on restructuring the school-age care program for the 2024-2025 school year due to the addition of the new program, and we will be contacting families on the waitlist for any spaces that are available.

For families with preschool-aged children born 2019, 2020, or 2021, our Licensed Preschool Summer Adventures Day camp is open for registration. We have been approved for the CCFRI for these camps, and therefore, the weekly fee is now \$114.25/5 days. Please register online or call the front desk to register.

7. Finance Report – Susie Jagpal (Howson)

Susie went through her report (see attached appendix 2). Highlights:

During Susie's presentation, Romina revealed the Carnival's grand profit of \$8819.59.

Year to Date, PAC has brought in \$37,637, with more to come. PAC's aim was \$30,000.

Total funds available \$93,471.71, expecting a further ~\$4,000. Discussed the necessity to keep at least \$15K and the rest for the playground.

'Teacher appreciation' allocation in the budget was discussed. This has not been used. There is inconsistency in how each class distributes gifts to the class teachers and support staff. It was decided that a guideline on how to give gifts to the teachers and support workers, etc., should be provided for the 'class reps.'

Eva Hossack requested \$200 for the 'Meet and Greet' with the teachers at the first PAC meeting. There will be food trucks outside. A portion of their sales will go to PAC. \$200 does not require to be motioned.

8. Fundraising report – Robyn Saona / Eva Hossack

Robyn presented (See slide show attached – Appendix 1).

Playground – see details in attached report.

Robyn, thanked Steve for running the playground survey.

Slight amendments were made to the chosen structure (proposal 2) in response to feedback in the survey made by students, parents and support staff. Students requested a platform between 2 existing structures, the triple ring fling and zipline, but unfortunately, due to safety, this was not allowed.

Robyn explained the phases. Phase 1 does not include the boogie board or wobble board. These would be added in Phase 2 within 6 months.

It was decided that the next steps would be for a Direct donation push for the exact amount PAC are short by. PAC would have 6 months to raise \$15K.

Carnival

Huge success all around. Students and families had a great time (great to see alumni, teachers and community members), praised for accessibility and inclusiveness.

Robyn thanked Romina for organizing the incredible event and thanked all donors and volunteers, including staff and teachers. It was only possible with their help.

Walk-a-thon 2024, Friday, May 17th – Brenda Brown

A very big thank-you to Mrs. Bender and Ms. Fung for all of their help with this year's Walkathon.

The kids won Rain and Shine gift cards, White Caps and Canucks prizes. For each lap a student completed and for each pledge they received, they got their name in the draw.

This year the students completed a total of 1961 laps around Douglas Park and pledges online (156) totaled \$6826. We are still waiting on the accounting from the VSB to determine the exact amount collected.

My expenses totalled \$531.23, so we hope to potentially net approximately \$6294.77 from this fundraiser.

I would also like to thank all of the parent volunteers who helped put on the day. We couldn't do this without you!

Fall 2024

Direct Donation Campaign: if **\$100 is donated per child for the year (or \$10 per month)**, we would reach our base fundraising goal of \$30k for the year. Encouraging families to make this direct donation right at the beginning of the school year.

These funds cover all of the programs, activities and initiatives that the PAC contributes to each year (activities such as pickleball and ultimate frisbee, projectors for the classrooms, funding for field trips, school performances, classroom supplies and library additions). These are all essential to our students' experiences at school!

The fundraising team will continue on strong fundraising push for further grounds improvements.

9. Hot lunch (foodie kids) update – Susannah Rohloff

Foodie Kids hot lunch has been running smoothly. We have about 65-75 orders each day. We will continue with the same program for next year. A big thank you to Ms. Fung and Ollie Hossack for helping out with the distribution!

10. Walking School Bus / Bike to School Week Update – Rosina Cuk/Caroline Liu

Rosina reported:

Walking School Bus is going to have a fun walk day to celebrate the success of the Walking School Bus year.

We do not know the future of the WSB as we do not have a sponsor secured yet for next year.

Bike to School Week ran from June 3rd to 7th. We logged 62 students participating in Bike to School Week and 325 bike trips made during the week. Thank you, teachers, for tracking those who walked to school. Last week, we logged 823 walk/roll trips. All the stats will be in this Friday June 14th and the \$1,000 active transportation prize will be announced next week.

Small Talk area worked very well as the bike lock-up area; if we are to lose that area next year, we will need to consider other lock-up solution.

Bike bus from the north side of Cavell ran relatively successfully this year. Thank you, Caroline Liu and Emma, for organizing the bike bus, also for the bike leaders and

crossing guard volunteers Nicole, Nitra, Kathryn, Nina, Cindy, Stacey, Seonju, Anita and Justine.

For future reference, we generally need 5 adults to bike along with the bike group. The kids' bike skills vary, and extra adults are needed when the kids drift or lag.

We would love to have parents and students from the south side of the school to join us next year.

Overall, it was a successful week. We would be interested in organizing again next year!

11. Chairs' report – Alison Seto / Brenda Brown

Grad update – It will be a Vintage Hollywood Theme, with DJ, chocolate fountain, and popcorn machine.

12. Greening committee report – Steve MacIntyre / Janna Clearwater

Steve reported that once the application from VSB is approved to get planter boxes installed, we can apply for grant money. The estimated amount required is \$15K – installation, lumber and crushed limestone base. Kathryn McRae has offered to help with the grant writing.

FEEDBACK REGARDING SCHOOL GROUNDS

- Survey also gathered feedback and ideas regarding the school grounds in general which will be helpful in guiding future projects.
- Replace/convert gravel field to turf or grass, or repurpose for more basketball courts or other uses (concern expressed regarding gravel field consistently). Unfortunately the word from VSB so far is that we can not make any modifications to the gravel field. We will continue to pursue but so far no changes are possible.
- General accessibility improvements (one of the goals of the new playground expansion was to include accessible features).
- Shade for playground, benches and picnic tables around playground and in shade of trees north of playground, water fountain, better grass field, outdoor classroom, little forest/grove of trees on a hill, buddy bench, more basketball courts, etc. Lots of great ideas.

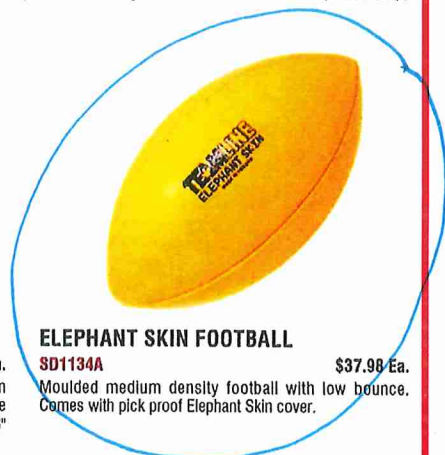

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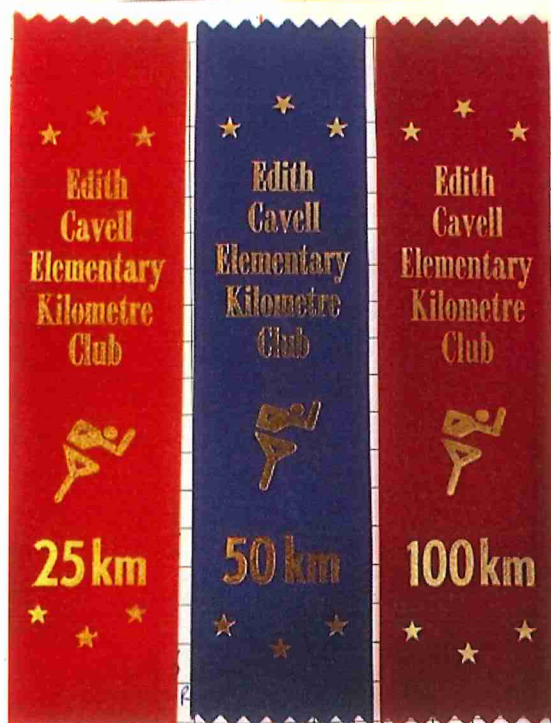
